Training and research has been done to understand the assessment tool and how to evaluate each parcel and rotation in a producers operation. Farming practices were also researched in order to understand how producers crop the land within their operations. Wages were paid out: District Administrator: 22 hours @ 57.68 = 1,268.96.
